

Journeyman Wireman Apprenticeship Program

Apprenticeships for this classification consist of five years of school and 8000 hours of on-the-job training. School is held in the evenings and some Saturdays. There are approximately 220 hours per year. Wages are based on a percentage of Journeyman Scale. Benefits include a pension, annuity and health insurance. These individuals work on all aspects of electrical installations for commercial and industrial construction, maintenance and modification projects. The wage structure is listed below.

Upon successful completion of school and attaining the 8000 hours of on-the-job training the apprentice will be advanced to Journeyman Wireman status and pay.

Tele-Data Journeyman Technician Apprenticeship

Apprenticeships for this classification consist of three years of school and 4800 hours of on-the-job training. School is held in the evenings and some Saturdays. There are approximately 180 hours per year. Wages are based on a percentage of Journeyman Technician Scale. Benefits include a pension, annuity and health insurance. These individuals install, modify and maintain telephone and computer equipment and cabling in many different environments. The wage structure is listed below.

5	70	3201-4000	Satisfactory Progress and 6 Months
6	80	4001-4800	3 rd Year of School and 6 Months

Upon successful completion of school, attaining the 4800 hours of on-the-job training and meeting the elapsed time requirements the apprentice will be advanced to Journeyman Technician status and pay.
